

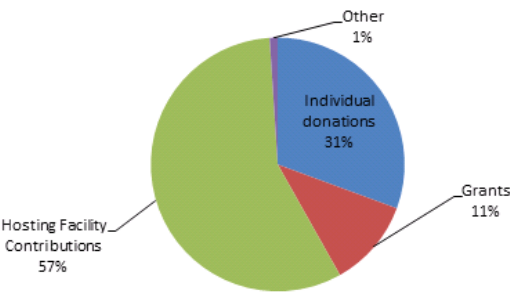

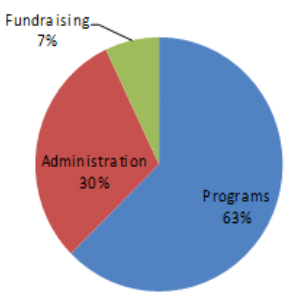

Executive Director's Report

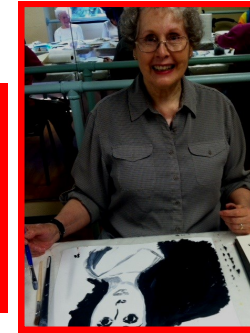

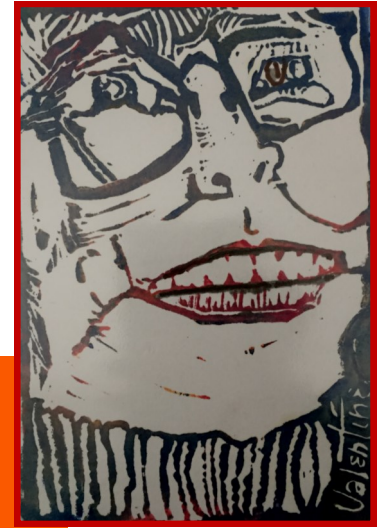
